One Commissioner for a five (5) year term commencing on January 1, 2022 and ending on December 31, 2026.

Candidates for the District Office of Commissioner shall declare their candidacy by submitting a letter in writing signed by them to the Fire District Secretary informing her of his/her intention to be a candidate for office and describing the office and term of office which he/she seeks. Such letter must be filed with the District Secretary no later than November 24, 2021.

All residents of the Fire District duly registered with the Suffolk County Board of Elections as of November 22, 2021 shall be eligible to vote.

Please be advised that the Board of Elections of the Fire District shall meet on November 29, 2021 from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM at the Fire District office for the purpose of preparing the rolls of the registered voters of the Fire District.

NOTICE of ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a meeting of the qualified voters of the Hauppauge Fire District in the Towns of Smithtown and Islip, Suffolk County, New York, will be held at the Main Firehouse of the Hauppauge Fire District, 855 Wheeler Road, Hauppauge, New York, on December 14, 2021, between the hours of 2:00 o'clock P.M. and 9:00 o'clock P.M., time then prevailing for the purpose of:

Electing one (1) Fire Commissioner for a term of five (5) years, commencing January 1, 2022 upon the expiration of the term of ROBERT L. WIND, present incumbent;

Every candidate for District office must, at the time of this Election, be a resident elector of the Fire District and shall have filed his name with the Secretary of the Fire District at least twenty (20) days prior to the date of the Fire District Election. In addition thereto, the Board of Fire Commissioners has provided by resolution that nominations of candidates for Fire District offices be submitted in petition form subscribed by twenty-five (25) qualified voters of the District. In 2021 said petition must be filed with the Secretary of the Fire District on or before November 24, 2021. A copy of the official form of the petition may be obtained from Mr. Michael Buturla, District Secretary, at 855 Wheeler Road, Hauppauge, New York, Monday through Friday during business hours (631-265-2542).

Every elector of the aforesaid Towns who shall have resided in the Fire District for a period of thirty (30) days next preceding any Election of Fire District officers and who on the date of said election is otherwise qualified to vote and is registered under the provisions of Article 5 of the Election Law shall be qualified to vote for such officers.

Please note that only those persons who have registered with the County Board of Elections on or before the 23rd day before the Fire District election day shall be eligible to vote. In 2021, such registration must have taken place on or before November 22, 2021.
